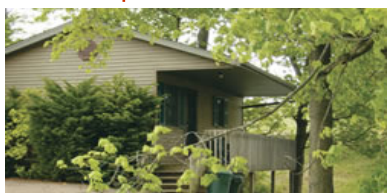

## How do you store your fibers?

Anyone who has cross stitched for any length of time can tell you how quickly all the little bits of threads can accumulate.

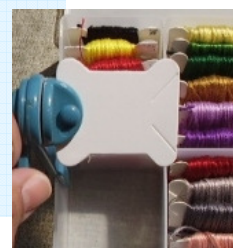
One idea is to use small floss-a-way bags to easily store floss. The bags keep the floss protected from dirt and water and are easy to take with you on a trip.



Plastic containers with dividers also work

wonderful. Clear containers allow you to see inside for a quick visual of the colors available. Plus, all containers allow you to put stickers or labels on the outside of the container. For easy searching, just write the floss number on the sticker or label. Do you have floss left over from kits or previous projects? If so, separate the colors and wind each color around its own floss bobbin.

Floss bobbins come in many styles. The ones



people are most familiar with are square pieces of cardboard that fit nicely into plastic containers with dividers. How do *you* store *your* fibers? Email us at [staff@crossmyheartltd.com](mailto:staff@crossmyheartltd.com) and let us know!

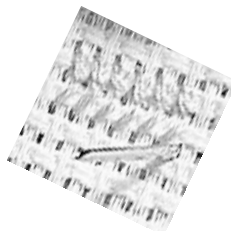

## Class Schedule

### Beginning Cross Stitch

Level: Beginner

Learn some basics to make your stitching easier. You will learn to separate strands of floss, thread your needle and start stitching! The basic cross stitch and backstitch will be covered along with how to read a graph. By the end of this course, you should be able to pick up almost any pattern and know what to do next. A great refresher course for the self-taught as well.

### Beginning Linen

#### Victoria Sampler "Hardanger Wreath"

Using dove's eyes is another way to strengthen and support open bars in hardanger. Wrapped bars allow larger squares and work up quickly. Dove's Eyes are easy to master and give a delicate look to the design. Cross stitched roses adorn the corners and a small gold colored heart charm is placed in the center. Please bring sharp scissors to class with you.
